



2.6 Physicians with **International** Postgraduate Training in **Family Medicine** recognized by the CFPC and who are **ELIGIBLE** for certification without examination by the CFPC

TO QUALIFY FOR A PROVISIONAL LICENCE UNDER THE ABOVE-NAMED CRITERIA, A PHYSICIAN MUST:

- a) Demonstrate that the physician meets the requirements that apply to all applicants for licensure;
 - English Language Proficiency*, and
 - Credential Verification*, and
 - Examinations, and
 - Currency of Practice, and
 - Good Character, and
 - Good Standing.
(Please see the CPSS website for details regarding the above points); **and**,
- b) Be eligible to attain CCFP without examination.
- c) Have passed the MCCQE1 or successfully completed medical licensing examinations in the United States of America acceptable to the Council.

PATHWAY TO REGULAR LICENSURE

1. Successfully practise with a supervisor until meeting the requirements for a regular licence; **and**,
2. Attain certification with the College of Family Physicians of Canada within one year of attaining provisional licensure; **and**,
3. Successfully engage in supervised practice in Canada for five years; **or**,
4. Attain the LMCC or successfully complete medical licensing examinations in the United States of America acceptable to the Council.

IMPORTANT: *If a physician has not met the requirements for a regular licence and is not practising under supervision, or the supervision does not comply with the requirements for supervision established by the Council, the Registrar will notify the physician of the intention to suspend the physician's licence within 15 days after notice is given.*

The College will automatically revoke the licence of a physician who fails to meet one or more of these requirements.

* Required if you are a physician with a foreign medical degree.
