



## New to the Licensure Renewal Form in 2022



Greetings!

The following summarizes some of the changes and enhancements that have been made to the Licensure Renewal Platform for 2022 (to renew your medical licence for the 2023 year).

1. **Two new health-related questions have been added:** The College's health-related renewal questions, included in [Bylaw 3.1](#) of the CPSS Regulatory Bylaws, were amended by the Council, since the last renewal period. The amendments bring the questions in alignment with those posed on the Application for Medical Regulation (AMR) on the [physicansapply.ca](#) website. They also serve to meet the requirements of the newly approved '[Blood-borne Viruses: Screening, Reporting and Monitoring of Physicians/Medical Students](#)' Policy, that was approved in 2021. 2. **Explanatory notes have been added:** To help you with navigating some of the more technical or legally based questions, outlined in Bylaw 3.1. You will see notes situated below a question that provide examples or descriptions to help you answer the question with more accuracy and understanding.
3. **Documents can be uploaded directly within the platform:** This capacity has been expanded from last year, to improve your ease with completing your renewal. Please note, if your revalidation cycle ended in December 2021 or June 2022, you will need to upload your Completion Certificate in order to proceed with your online renewal. You may wish to take action early and download a copy of your certificate from either the [MainPro](#) or [MOC MainPort](#) portals and keep it handy for this coming renewal season.
